Simply give us a call and we will add you to the snail mail list.

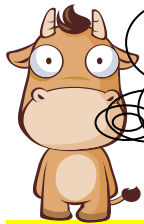
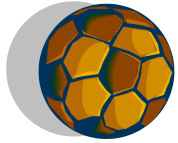
