

## **Entry Classifications:**

**Section A: Blooming/Fruiting Plants**— Must have flowers or fruit

Grown specifically for blooms/fruit, unless there is a specific section for the plant( i.e. cactus, violets, orchids)

**Section B: Bromeliads and Orchids**

Class 1— with Bloom

Class 2— without Bloom

**Section C: Cactus/ Succulents/ Euphorbias**

Class 1— with Bloom

Class 2— without Bloom

**Section D: African Violets**

Class 1— with Bloom

Class 2— without Bloom

**Section E: Foliage**

Includes all plants grown for foliage , and plants without flowers or fruit, variegated, colored and or green, tropical or landscape

**Section F: Special Display**

Dish gardens, wire framed , topiaries, terrariums,

**Section G: Bonsai**

All sizes and styles in pots, trays, or racks

**Section H: Hanging Plants**

All hanging plants , including wood mounts that are meant to hang

Class 1— Blooming/ Fruiting—Must have flowers/fruit

Class 2— Non Blooming/ Fruiting

**Section I: Patio Plants**

All containers 14” or over that are not hanging

Class 1— Blooming/Fruiting

Class 2— Non-Blooming/Fruiting

**Edible or Food Producing Exhibits:**

( Eggs and perishable exhibits will be removed as deemed necessary)

**Section J: Herbs**

Potted Only

**Section K: Vegetables/Crops**

Class 1-Potted

Class2— Cut and/ or Unpotted

**Section L: Fruits/Nuts**

Class 1-Potted

Class2— Cut and/ or Unpotted

**Section M: Miscellaneous**

Class1— Best Jar of Honey

Class2— Best of Cane Syrup

**Section N: Eggs**

Class 1— Chicken Eggs

Class 2— Miscellaneous Eggs: Turkey, Duck, Peafowl, Quail, Ostrich, Emu, Rhea
