

Rules for Showing Eggs at the Fair

Care:

All reasonable efforts will be made to provide adequate care and protection for exhibits during the fair. The Fair Association and the Bradford County Extension Service are not responsible for damage to exhibits due to weather conditions or improper care or handling.

Entry Limitations:

One type of egg is considered one entry.

Exhibitors may not enter more than one type of the same variety and color.

Entries are limited to ½ dozen of each type and/or color.

Egg Standards:

All eggs must be clean and without obvious blemishes or cracks.

Judging:

The decisions of the judges are final. Judging will take place on Tuesday, March 11th, from 1 pm to 3 pm.

Attractiveness of Display:

Display the eggs attractively, but the eggs should be the focus- not the display. A small basket, pot or container is appropriate. Please do not display eggs in a Styrofoam egg carton.

Examples of Types of Eggs:

Chicken, Turkey, Duck, Peafowl, Quail, Ostrich, Emu, Rhea

Best in Class	Rosette	\$5.00
Best in Show	Rosette	\$10.00
