General Rules and Regulations
Saturday, November 14, 2009
8:30am – Check-in/Registration
9:00am – Show Begins**

- 1. No livestock or large animals are allowed.**
- 2. All dogs must be on a leash, all other animals must be confined to carrier or crate.**
- 3. All dogs, cats, and ferrets must have a current rabies certificate and tag within last year from a veterinarian**
- 4. All judges decisions are final**
- 5. No aggressive animal behavior will be tolerated. If your animal cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave.**
- 6. All animals must be healthy and show no signs of sickness or disease.**
- 7. Unsportsmanlike conduct or cruelty to animals will not be tolerated.**
- 8. The Bradford County 4-H Clubs, Bradford County 4-H Council, Bradford County Fair Association, and Bradford County Extension Service will not be responsible for any accident or loss that may occur to any animal, person, or vehicle, nor damage to any vehicle.**
- 9. All participants must wear closed toed shoes (no flip-flops or sandals).**
- 10. Costumes must be safe for child and pet**
- 11. All participants need to be prepared to talk to the judges about their pets**
- 12. Only Cloverbuds will be allowed to have a parent/adult with them in the ring.**
- 13. All age divisions will be judged together – it is the animal that is being judged and receiving the award.**
- 14. If registered in “Best Trick” Category, must supply own props and animal must perform the trick.**
- 15. Minimum of 2 entries in a class or class will be cancelled.**
- 16. Must have a minimum of 20 entries by November 9th or pet show will be cancelled.**
